

Paragraph 1

Write an introduction paragraph. Be sure to answer the following questions:

- What is the book's title and author?
- Who the person your book is about?
- Why is that person famous for?
- What is a famous or inspirational quote that your person is know for?

Paragraph 2

Describe your famous person's childhood. Be sure to answer the following questions:

- When and where were they born?
- What was their family life like (did they grow up with both parents? Any brothers and sisters?)
- Was there anything significant that happened in their life that relates to why they are famous?
- Did they have any dreams as he or she was growing up? Did they ever want to be anything else when they were young?

Paragraph 3

Describe your famous person's adulthood. Be sure to answer the following questions:

- What was their education level?
- What was their occupation when they grew up?
- Where did the live as they became an adult?
- What do you think was the major turning point in their lives to give them the opportunity to be who they became?

Paragraph 4

Describe your famous person's accomplishments. Be sure to answer the following questions:

- What did this person accomplish that makes him or her memorable?
- What contribution did this person make to society? Did they help others in any way (volunteer at a homeless shelter, donate money to the needy)?
- Do you think this person struggled much to reach his or her dreams? Why do you feel this way?

Paragraph 5

Write a conclusion paragraph. Be sure to answer the following questions:

- If you met this person today, what is one question you would ask them?
- What is the most interesting fact you learned about you famous person?
- What do you have in common with that person?

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Anne Frank Script

Hi, My name is Anne Frank. I was born on June 12, 1929 in Frankfurt am Main. I am famous because I wrote a diary while in hiding during the time of the Nazi's in Germany. Five important events in my life were Hitler becoming Chancellor of Germany and passing Anti-Jewish laws, getting an autographed book from my dad that I decided to use as a diary, moving to Amsterdam, having to go into hiding from my family to conceal ourselves from the German government, and my mother dying from starvation in a concentration camp. An interesting fact about me is that I named my diary, "Kitty". My contribution to society was a first hand account of what it was like to be a Jewish girl during the time of Adolf Hitler. I helped people in the future learn about what he did and how he treated people just because they were different. One quote I know for is, "Despite everything, I believe people are really good at heart."
